Van Gogh interacted with many artists in a short period of 10 years, from aspiring to painter at the age of 27 to dying at the age of 37. And he absorbed various influences received from them and created his own style.

This exhibition focuses on the Hague School and Impressionism that have had a major influence on Van Gogh. Compare their works, and clarify exchanges of them by letters that Van Gogh exchanged with family and friends.

Focus on the unknown side of great artists.
